CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT

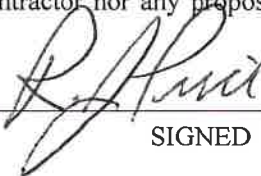

Additionally, Bidder/Contractor is advised that once the Prohibited Entities List is posted on the OGS Website, any Bidder/Contractor seeking to renew or extend a Contract or assume the responsibility of a Contract awarded in response to this solicitation must certify at the time the Contract is renewed, extended or assigned that it is not included on the Prohibited Entities List.

During the term of the Contract, should the City receive information that a Bidder/Contractor is in violation of the above-referenced certification, the County will offer the person or entity an opportunity to respond. If the person or entity fails to demonstrate that he/she/it has ceased engagement in the investment which is in violation of the Act within 90 days after the determination of such violation, then the County shall take such action as may be appropriate including, but not limited to, imposing sanctions, seeking compliance, recovering damages or declaring the Bidder/Contractor in default.

The County reserves the right to reject any bid or request for assignment for a Bidder/Contractor that appears on the Prohibited Entities List prior to the award of a contract and to pursue a responsibility review with respect to any Bidder/Contractor that is awarded a contract and subsequently appears on the Prohibited Entities List.

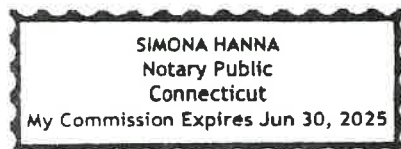

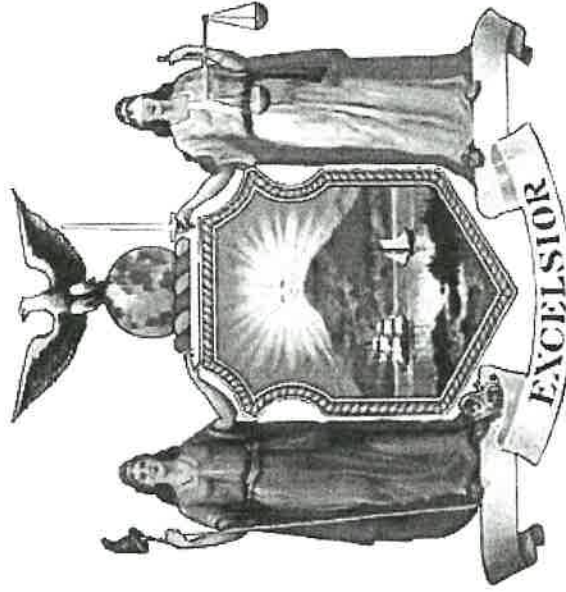

1. Is a bid bond/security required for this bid?

2. Are Payment and/or Performance bonds be required for the project?

3. Detail 1/D-1 for the stone dust path indicates various compaction rates for subbase and base material, however, the specs for grading and filling around trees on page 108 of the bid documents (spec section 31 10 00 – 2.3-C) states that no compaction is to be performed under the drip line of trees. Since a significant portion of the path runs under the drip line of the large established trees in the park (and therefore we cannot excavate but must instead build-up the new path atop the existing grades), please clarify how the path should be constructed without compaction under the driplines.

Refer to Stone Dust Pavement Specification (Item 623.1000000NY) page 2 of 3 for compaction effort within the dripline of existing trees.

4. Since the path will be installed atop the existing grade, please clarify how wide or at what slope the topsoil/lawn restoration along the sides of the path should be in the areas where it is higher than the existing grade.

No fill is to be placed within 3' of tree trunks. In other fill locations the topsoil is to be placed at new stone dust path elevation and tapered 8' on either side of path to existing grade. No additional compensation will be provided for grading and topsoil. It is to be included in the unit prices for stone dust path – Items 4 and 5.

5. The specs state all excavation taking place within the dripline of trees must be performed by a certified tree surgeon. If for some reason excavation must take place instead of building up the path, will the Owner provide additional compensate to the contractor for a tree surgeon's services?

A certified tree surgeon will not be required. Any excavation, if required, shall be done under the direction of the City Engineer or his designated representative.

6. Does the steel edging need to be 5" high? I can't seem to find 5" locally that will support the details. I can get 4" steel in green or black. 5" is a special order, and they wouldn't be able to guarantee delivery in the time frame you're looking to complete the job.

4" high steel will suffice

7. Please confirm steel edging is to be 5" high considering that the combined height of the base course and top course for the path is to be 10".

4" high steel will suffice

8. Since the new path will need to be placed atop the existing grades (because of the driplines), please confirm the final elevations of the playground will match the final elevation of the built-up path that is to run along the edge of the playground.

The final elevations will match.

9. Please confirm if all testing and inspections will be provided and paid for by the Owner.

10. Please clarify the type/size of construction fence that must be utilized, and the full/complete extent of where it is to be placed.

A construction fence is to be placed at the limits of the contractor's work area and around the staging area. Construction fencing should also be placed at the drip line of trees where practical and AOB. The fence should be of size and type to prevent park patrons from entering work areas and to secure staging area. The City will not be responsible for vandalism or damage to the contractor's vehicles, equipment and material.

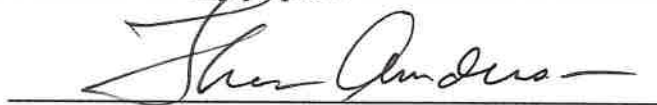
